Program Details

Eligible employees can receive discounted tuition (25% flat-rate discount for Staff & Administrators and \$350 per credit hour rate for Active Teachers), free textbooks for undergraduates and locked in tuition rates, for two years of continuous enrollment, through a partnership between Eastern Kentucky University and Estill County Schools.

The EKU Advantage partnership will provide eligible employees with greater accessibility to the various on-campus and online educational programs at Eastern Kentucky University.

Family members are not eligible for the discount, and proper documentation is required.

Once the employee has completed the application for admissions, they will receive an email communication from EKU to contact Andrea to get and then upload their Confirmation of Employment Letter. Once the letter has been uploaded to the EKU Corporate Educational Partnership website: https://corporate.eku.edu/corporate-education-partnerships-proof-employment, the employee will receive an email that the letter was verified. (This may take a few days.) The tuition discount will appear on the EKU billing statement as a reduction of the total tuition amount on the bill.
