

## Guidelines for Military Recruiters in the Building

We at Estill County High School have a high regard for those serving in the military and we respect the fact the many of our students have benefited from their time spent serving our country. We have always had an open door policy with the armed forces being in our building more so than any of the high schools in our vicinity. However, noting the intense commitment required by the Military and the fact that these are indeed minors, we ask that recruiters please adhere the following guidelines.

Recruiters may come into the building every 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday. If they are not able to come on the scheduled date, they must wait until the next 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday. They may set up in the cafeteria during 3<sup>rd</sup> block but they should not cause students to be late or miss class. If a student chooses to miss lunch to speak to a recruiter, then that is OK. If the recruiter would like to speak to a student beyond third block, they must schedule an appointment with the student before or after school or during a teacher aide block. Please note that if a recruiter does indeed set up an appointment for further discussions with a student, **then the recruiter is responsible for notifying the guidance office immediately allowing the guidance office the opportunity to call the parents of the student. The Estill County High School will attempt to notify parents anytime a recruiter chooses to meet with an individual student. If the student is under 18 years of age, the parent MUST be notified prior to a recruiter meeting with a student on an individual basis.**

In the future, the parents of the students will be notified in writing before September 15<sup>th</sup> of each school year, that recruiters will be in the building and that the names of all the students will be provided to those recruiters unless the parent disallows it.

Finally, Estill County High School will include the dates that recruiters will be in the building on its Senior Calendars and Parent Newsletters. If a 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday falls on a snow day, then the next available Thursday will be the makeup day. Thank you for your cooperation.
